This permit authorises the permit holder and any current NSW State Emergency Service personnel to possess the prohibited weapon listed in this permit for use as part of the Service's response to all requests for assistance.


All personnel handling the prohibited weapon must complete the internal training provided by NSW State Emergency Service relating to the safe operating techniques required for correct use of the prohibited weapon known as an 'arborist type slingshot'.

The authority conferred by a prohibited weapon permit is subject to the *Weapons Prohibition Act 1998* and the associated Regulation and all the General Legislative Requirements that apply to a prohibited weapon permit holder¹ (and which are relevant to this permit) apply to this permit, in addition to the conditions outlined below.

Conditions:

1. The permit holder must ensure that Level 1 safe keeping requirements, as prescribed by section 32B of the *Weapons Prohibition Act 1998*, are maintained for the prohibited weapons to which this permit relates.
2. The permit holder and NSW State Emergency Service personnel are not authorised to possess or use the prohibited weapon for any purpose other than that set out in the authority above.
3. The permit holder must ensure the safe handling and use of weapons at all times.
4. The permit holder must ensure a register is maintained by each SES Unit detailing names, time and dates when weapons are removed and when returned, the reasons for such removal and the responsible authorised SES Officer.

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5. The register maintained by each SES Unit must be immediately produced on demand by a police officer or other authorised person.
6. The permit holder must submit a copy of the registers to the Firearms Registry upon request and upon cancellation, revocation or expiry of this permit.

Safe storage address:

For the purpose of this permit, the prohibited weapons must be stored in approved safe storage where no access is available to non NSW State Emergency Service personnel, or dismantled and stored in a locked service vehicle under the direct control of NSW State Emergency Service personnel.


During operational periods the slingshots must be stored and/or transported in service vehicles under the direct control of qualified NSW State Emergency Service personnel.

Schedule 1 Prohibited Weapons

Clause 2(6) A slingshot (being a device consisting of an elasticised band secured to the forks of a "Y" shaped frame), other than a home-made slingshot for use by a child in the course of play.

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
